## Walsingham Academy Lower School BOYS Uniform Attire

(Uniforms are required for grades 1-7, optional for Kindergarten, Junior Kindergarten and Early Learners)

## Options for Tops:

White or cardinal short sleeve performance polo with school logo or cardinal long sleeve polo with school logo-must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms (Shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

## Options for Bottoms:

Light grey twill pants or light grey twill shorts—must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms (Shorts can be worn August-October and March-June.)

## Academy Dress Days(Minimum of One Set Needed):

Academy Dress days are special days in the Academy's calendar when we have a liturgy or other celebrations that require extra attention to uniform dress. White short or long sleeve Oxford shirt with school logo and a school tie purchased from Dennis School Uniforms or the Vineyard Vines school tie. Only on these days, boys are required to wear the light grey twill pants, Oxford shirt with school logo and school tie.

Outerwear Options: (year-round)
Black $1 / 4$ zip sweatshirt with school logo—must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms.
Black V-neck cardigan with school logo—must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms.

## Socks and Shoes:

Socks must be black or white and must be crew length. Shoes must be solid black or brown supportive shoes or Sperry-styled deck shoes. Athletic shoes which meet these requirements are allowed (see Addendum 1). Not Acceptable: Boots of any style, sandals, backless shoes, clogs.

## Belts:

A solid black or brown leather belt is required with no large belt buckles.

## Hair and Jewelry:

Boys' hair may not be longer than touching the top of their collar and eyebrows and no longer than the top of the ear lobe. Hair must be neatly groomed and cannot be colored with unnatural vivid colors. Unusual hairstyles (mohawks, young men wearing their hair up in ponytails or "man buns", etc.) are not allowed. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or any facial piercings.

## Walsingham Academy Lower School GIRLS Uniform Attire

(Uniforms are required for grades 1-7, optional for Kindergarten, Junior Kindergarten and Early Learners)

## Options for Tops:

White or cardinal short sleeve performance polo with school logo or cardinal long sleeve polo with school logo—must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms. (Shirts must be tucked in at all times.)

## Options for Bottoms:

Grades 1-5: Plaid jumper, plaid skort, light grey twill pants or light grey twill shorts- must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms (Shorts can be worn August-October and March- June, but not on Academy Dress Days. Jumpers/skorts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Shorts may not hang below hem of jumper/skort.)

Grades 6-7: Plaid skirt, light grey twill pants or light grey twill shorts- must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms (Shorts can be worn August-October and March- June, but not on Academy Dress Days. Skirts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee and cannot be rolled at the waist. Shorts may not hang below hem of skirt.)

## Academy Dress Days (Minimum of One Set Needed):

Academy Dress days are special days in the Academy's calendar when we have a liturgy or other celebrations that require extra attention to uniform dress. Girls white short or long sleeve Oxford shirt with school logo purchased from Dennis School Uniforms Only on these days, girls are required to wear the plaid skirt/skort/jumper or light grey twill pants and the Oxford shirt with school logo.

## Outerwear Options (year-round):

Black $1 / 4$ zip sweatshirt with school logo-must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms.
Black V-neck cardigan with school logo—must be purchased from Dennis School Uniforms.

## Socks and Shoes:

Socks must be black or white and must be crew length. Black or cardinal knee highs or tights. Shoes must be solid black or brown supportive shoes or Sperry-styled deck shoes. Athletic shoes which meet these requirements are allowed (see Addendum 1) Not Acceptable: Boots of any style, sandals, backless shoes, clogs.

Belts: A solid black or brown leather belt is required with no large belt buckles.

## Hair, Jewelry and Make-up:

Hair accessories must be plain white, black, grey, cardinal or school plaid. Hair must be neatly groomed and cannot be colored with unnatural vivid colors. Unusual hairstyles (mohawks, shaved head for ladies, etc.) are not allowed unless for medical reasons. Stud or small hoop or dangle earrings, a single necklace are acceptable for girls. If a girl wears a bracelet, no more than two will be allowed. Facial piercings are not allowed. No student will be permitted to wear make-up of any kind. If a child comes to school or applies make-up during the day, the child will be required to remove it. This includes nail polish.
